### **Grants**

There have been several grants given by the NRC to help BR members undertake the coaching course and thus become level 2 coaches. The grant fund has not been accessed as much as before the pandemic, perhaps the general rowing community in the North haven't realised that grants can be applied for to help with up to 50% of the costs of training. Usually up to around £6000 may be offered to people training towards qualifications which help rowing in the region.
