Notes

Competitors should not enter more than 3 events (excluding 8's). All events are subject to three to enter & two to row. If sufficient numbers are not available for B events, then these will automatically be rolled up to A events. For the Trainer boat events these will be supplied by CLS ARC.

* New to Sport – offered as primary events (none qualifying) for those competitors who started rowing after Jan 2011 and have not won any event, and not competing in any event other than 'New to Sport'
