Costs Associated With The GBRT U19 Strategy 2022/23

Also Other Opportunities For U16/England HIRR/Beach Sprints



It must be accepted by rowers and their clubs, parents/guardians, as well as coaches, that there are cost implications to allow rowers and their coaches to take part in the assessment and trialling process and ultimately to be part of any GB Rowing International Team.

Clubs which pay coaches may wish to consider how such payments can be managed to allow coaches to fully support young rowers ensuring they have the best chance of selection. This may include such items as working additional hours to attend GBRT U19 Events, extra training on home or other water. Also, the GBRT U19 Team Manager provides training guidance monthly on land and water based activities and these must be adapted to provide explicit individual training programme.

Coaches may be required to take time off work and arrange overnight accommodation to travel south and be available for early starts at events. An estimate of accommodation for additional nights is show in the table.

The information provided in the table below may assist with financial planning.
