JIRR Trials

The trials are set to take place on Saturday 5th March kindly hosted again by Cambois Rowing Club. Racing will be over 1500m. Entries are on BROE2 again this year and will close on Sunday 27th Feb. As we are an affiliated event a small charge of £1 per seat will be charged. I intend to use this to cover the cost of First Aid Cover at the trials. BR will not charge their usual fee.

The event this year is to be held in Nottingham with the course back to 1500m.

GB Junior Selection

U19

The next two assessments are: 5km r26 ergo assessment by Mon 7 Feb water assessment 19 & 20 February at Boston Rowing Club, entries by 12:00 noon on Mon 14th Feb. The last time Feb trials were held was 2019. The format this year introduces several changes which will be covered in the online event briefing on Tue 15 Feb at 19:30.

The ergo standards remain <=17:40.0 (U19M) and <=19:50.0 (U19W). However, there is an increased water standard from EID: U19M should have been ranked higher than 32nd and U19W ranked higher than 40th.

Sat races will be over 5000m apart from U19 2- who will race over 3000m

This year Sunday partnerships for U19 W 2x / W 2- and U19 M 2x will be arranged by GBRT based on Sat results and races over 5000m.

U19 M 2- have three runs over 3000m, two on Sat one on Sun. The results of run 1 on Sat will determine the number of three boat matrices in different partnerships over run 2 and 3.

<u>U16</u>

The U16 trial will run alongside the U19 trials. In order to enter this trial rowers should have achieved a time of \leq 18:15.0 (JM16) or \leq 20:30.0 (JW16) for a 5k ergo test at a maximum rate of 26. Entries by 12:00 noon on Mon 14th Feb.

The U16s will race in 1x over 5000m on Sat and an opportunity to form 2x for the Sunday.
