2000m individual races on Concept 2 Rowing Machine and a 3000m Team Challenge

Categories:

- Allcomers: open to all athletes
- University: open to all current university students with BUCS points available
- **Veterans:** using the Concept 2 handicapping system
- College: open to all students who are not competing for DUBC but are in a Durham College

The above categories are available in male and female, heavyweight and lightweight.

• **Team Challenge:** 3000m in teams of four for Durham University College Novices and Seniors, Allcomers, College Sports Clubs and the Interdepartmental teams.

Lightweight men must be on or below 75kg; Lightweight women must be on or below 61.5kg. Weigh-in will be between two and one hours before your race.

BUCS:

BUCS points will be awarded to the fastest four university competitors from all of the regions in the country in the available categories.

Points available are: 1st place = 12, 2nd place = 8, 3rd place = 6, 4th place = 4.

The Sports Centre will be open from 10am for warm-up with the first race starting at 10.45am. 16 ergos will be used to race in each slot and there will be 8 available to warm up on. Refreshments will be available throughout the day.
