Coxless Pairs: Elite, IM1, IM2, IM3, J18,17,16,15, Masters

Double Sculls: Elite, IM1, IM2, IM3, Novice, J18 to J12, Masters

Single Sculls: Elite, IM1, IM2, IM3, Novice, J18 to J12, Masters

*Masters must state their category on entry.*

*A&B categories offered in all Junior events*

*All J13's and below **must** use macon blades*

## Conditions of Entry

1. The Regatta is open to all Club and Composite crews and is held under British Rowing Rules of Racing.
2. Talkin Tarn Regatta is a three-lane course using stake-boats, please ensure that all coxes and those in coxless boats are able to back down onto a stake-boat.
3. All entries must be made via BR Online Entry by 12:00 on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> June.
4. The draw will take place on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> June and will be published by Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> June on the Talkin Tarn Amateur Rowing Club website, [www.talkintarnarc.co.uk](http://www.talkintarnarc.co.uk)
5. All entry fee payments must be made online via OARA by Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> June.
6. In the event of the Regatta being cancelled, half of the entry fees will be refunded.
7. Competitors must be in the start (marshalling) area 5 minutes before the time of the race.
8. Competitors must provide their own boats and blades.
9. All events are to be raced in fine boats.
- 10. Junior 13 competitors and below must use macon blades for racing.**
11. Please state status/age group of crews and state clearly if NOT prepared to compete in the next highest status or age group.
12. Competitors may not enter in more than three events (excluding Club 8+). Sharing competitors/boats/blades/coxes must be notified with entry.
13. At least three entries to make an event – two at the Committee's discretion.
14. All boats must be fitted with a plastic number plate fitting, to slot numbers on the bows.
15. Coxes requiring dead weight must bring their own, clearly identifiable, weights.
16. The Regatta Committee reserve the right to alter the list of entries after publication. Every reasonable effort shall be made to ensure all entries get a race.
17. Junior A and B statuses may be combined in a given event, if insufficient entries are received in either.
18. Masters Handicaps will be applied at the start in accordance with guidance laid down in the British Rowing Almanac.
19. New To Sport event is offered as primary events (non qualifying) for those competitors who began rowing after September 2011 and have not won any event.
