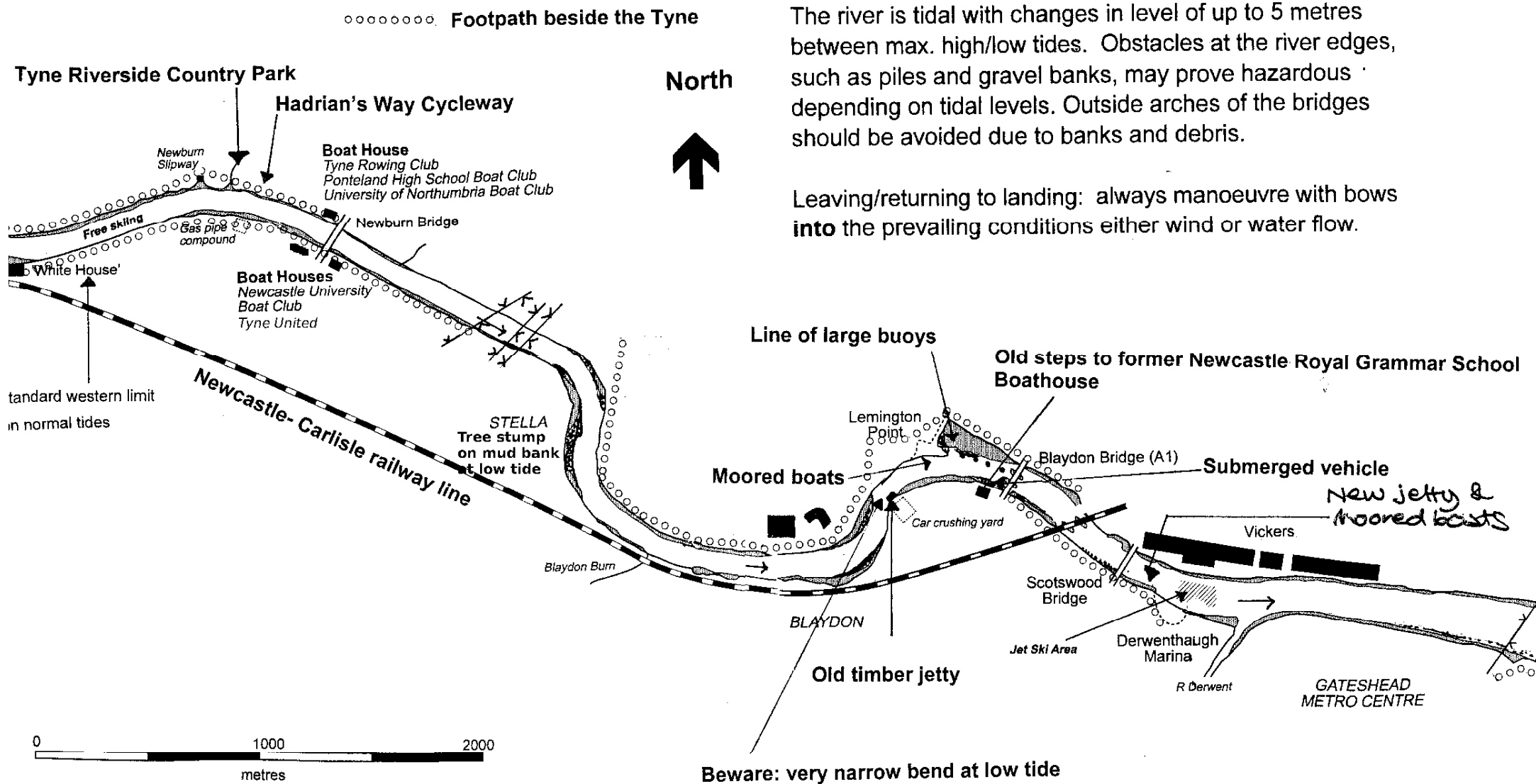


The River Tyne

Newburn to Scotswood



The river is tidal with changes in level of up to 5 metres between max. high/low tides. Obstacles at the river edges, such as piles and gravel banks, may prove hazardous depending on tidal levels. Outside arches of the bridges should be avoided due to banks and debris.

Leaving/returning to landing: always manoeuvre with bows **into** the prevailing conditions either wind or water flow.
