Terms and Conditions:

1. In the event of the regatta being cancelled by the Race Committee either in part or in whole, the Committee reserves the right to refund up to 50% of entry fees to crews which have not raced.
2. The committee reserves the right to withdraw any event with fewer than 3 entries.
3. Entrants should indicate if they are not willing to be moved up in status in the event of insufficient entries in their preferred event.
4. Lightweight men and women will be weighed not more than two hours nor less than one hour before the published time of the first race in the event.
5. Competitors must be at the start 5 minutes before the time of the race. Competitors will not be called for their races and the Starter will start all races without reference to absentees.
6. All competitors must produce an ARA racing licence on demand.
7. Clubs are reminded that it is their responsibility to insure equipment.
8. All boats must be fitted with slots for numbers on the bows.
9. Race control will be located at Tyne RC
10. Boating is expected to take place from both Tyne RC and Newcastle University BC. Clubs will be advised of their boating location by the Committee
11. The draw will be made available at tyneregatta.org as soon as possible after the close of entries.
